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We can use **relative pronouns/clauses** to refer back to an earlier noun. We use **whom** instead of **who** after a preposition

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to **devote** = to give your time, love or effort to something you believe in

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A **perspective** is a particular way of considering something, or a position from which we view something

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We can also use **those** with a prepositional phrase to refer to particular groups of people

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This phrase lets us introduce an idea/point which some people might not consider

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We can use **the** with nouns based on adjectives, to refer to particular groups of people

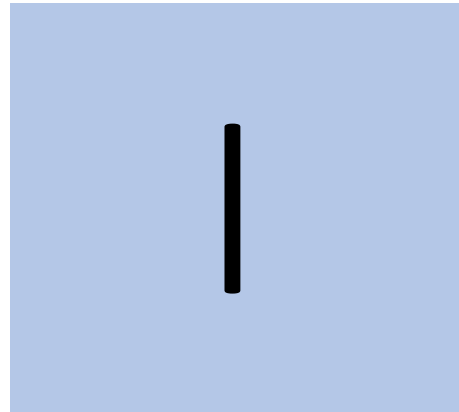
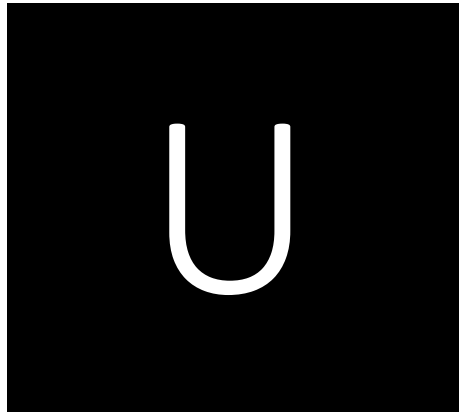
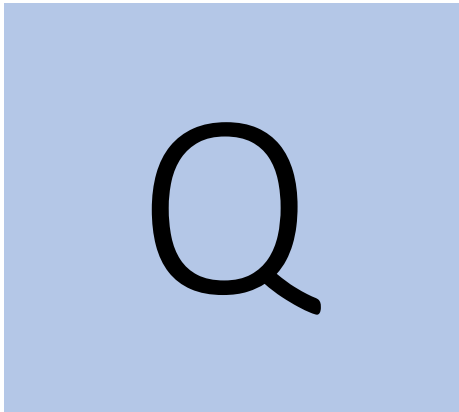
